# **Class Update**

We studied **Animal Names used as Verbs** this week and discussed at length why these animals were used for these verbs. The students showed keen observations skills when we talked about this in class as they connected certain movements in the animals or stories connected to the animal or even characteristics often associated with the animal to decipher the meaning of these verbs. In doing this, they not only enriched their **Vocabulary**, they also honed their **Reading Comprehension** skills of connecting Prior Knowledge to text and Visualizing the unknown text to understand its meaning. They also wrote sentences for some of these verbs and reviewed **subject-verb agreement** in the process.

Aside from the components of Vocabulary and Reading Comprehension, they were also re-introduced to **Phrasal Verbs** – what these are, what words are included in these phrases (*prepositions and verbs*) and which verbs are often paired up with which prepositions (*see the Animal Names as Verbs ppt for reference*). They also were given notes on how to modify the Phrasal Verbs further by adding certain prepositions to the sentence (ex. pig out *on* (food).

The students put together an <u>Animal Names as Verbs booklet</u> to complement and support our class discussions. This will also act as a support for the Worksheets and Workbook activities we have in class.

You might have noticed that the students also brought home booklets on suffixes right before the holidays. These are meant to function as reviewers as each booklet has a pile of words with certain suffixes stapled to it and the changed meaning of these words based on the suffix attached to it. These booklets also have a space for sentences as the students are always encouraged and expected to use the words we learn to convey complete and relevant ideas.

As these reviewers and booklets need to be stored and compiled for the students' easy access, kindly assist in providing them with A5 level arched binders and punchers. In addition to these items, it would be a good idea to supply them with scissors, stick glue and colour pencils so as to facilitate and expedite our hands-on activities. A list of tools and stationery, as well as pictures if needed, is in an attachment with the email that this came with. Kindly assist in making sure that your child has a set by next Monday, 10 Sept.

<u>Please note that these activities are meant to support and not replace our worksheets and workbook activities.</u> I merely want to make sure that each and every concept and skill they are mapped to learn by and in Primary 4 are solidly in place before we move on to the next.

## **Topical Review 2**

The Primary 4 TR 2 is scheduled this Wednesday and will cover Reading Comprehension, Vocabulary (Spelling Words) and Connectors for Compound Sentences.

The students' spelling test will be absorbed by the TR and, hence, they WILL NOT have a separate spelling test on that day.

We are set to discuss connectors tomorrow and will use Tuesday to review and prepare for TR2.

#### "What does this word mean?"

Encourage their curiousity by equipping them with knowledge of where they can find the information on their own. In this case, they may use their Dictionary in print or go to **Ms Chie's Bookshelf Tab > Word Helpers > Dictionary.**
